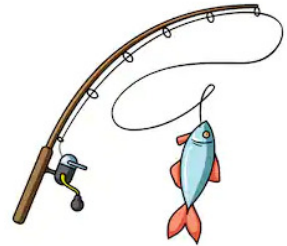

Fishing

SJRE manages and stocks, **for its members**, 1st-class fishing along the river and in the pond. Please adhere to the following rules to preserve this privilege:

- Sign-in at the box with lot # and owner's name (back of badge)
- Current fishing badges must be visibly worn while fishing (exception: under 16 years old, a supervising adult may wear the badge)
- Overnight guests in your cabin are allowed to fish without your presence; owners must accompany or be in the general area of non-overnight guests who are fishing. All guests must follow all fishing rules and must sign in/out and wear a badge.
- Don't forget to sign-out with all required information
- Please, help enforce our fishing policies.



Watch for People and Animals

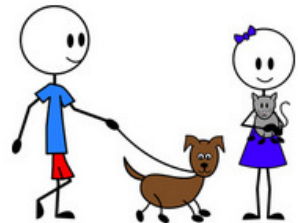
We have MANY folks that love to walk and bicycle the roads. Please, watch for people and the wild animals and respect the speed limit of 20mph **or less**. Slow down and enjoy the views that SJRE has to offer.



Pets

We all love our pets. Note that your pets do need to be kept under owner control at all times and please pickup after them.

Water

SJRE manages one of the best water systems in the state. Due to Colorado laws **no vehicle washing or outdoor watering**. Please conserve water as much as possible.

Safe Grill & Fires Reminders

Part of the enjoyment of being in the mountains is cooking outside. Safe grilling reminds us:

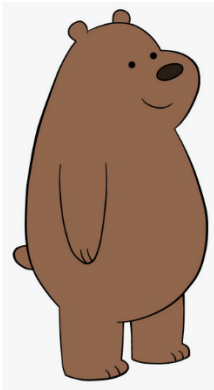
- Please move the gas grill away from the house by at least 10 feet before use.
- Once cooled please move it back under the porch to protect it from the sudden winds that may occur and the bears that love grilled food, also!
- Lake City is usually under a stage 1 fire ban, which is no open fires except in approved fireplaces. At Stage 2, there are no fires allowed at all.



da BEARS

Yes ... we share this area with bears ... be VERY respectful of them.

- Bears have a keen sense of smell and will investigate anything that has an odor out of the ordinary, especially food.
- Remove all food, trash, etc. from your vehicles and keep your vehicles locked ... bears know how to open doors!
- Keep all garbage inside the cabin or in the designated bear-proof container.
- Keep the windows and doors, those accessible by bears, closed when you are away from the house and at night.



Dark Skies

Some of the best viewing of stars and the night sky is right here in Lake City. **Be a good neighbor, please keep use of outdoor lights at a minimum so everyone can enjoy the nights.** It is encouraged that no outdoor lights be left on after you retire for the night.

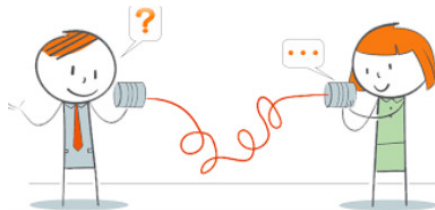


TRASH
